### 3<sup>rd</sup> Transnational Project Meeting

#### SELCERT: Skills Development and Certification for Trainers of Synchronous Electronic Learning

The 3rd Transnational Meeting of the project SELCERT: Skills Development and Certification for Trainers of Synchronous Electronic Learning, coordinated by EURO-IDEA and hosted by MMC, took place in Nicosia, Cyprus on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of September 2023. All six partners participated physically in the meeting (CCC, FU, ASNOR, EURO-IDEA, DIMITRA and OMEGATECH). During these two days of meeting, all participating partners contributed to the smooth execution of the meeting.

The first day of the meeting started with a welcoming note from the host of the transnational meeting, MMC, and then a welcoming note from the project's coordinator, EURO-IDEA. The project's coordinator brought to attention some clarifications regarding the development of the curriculum in accordance with the learning outcomes specified in the qualification framework and the development of the training materials. All partners agreed on a mutual deadline for the completion of the training materials. Additionally, CCC, as the leading organisation of PR2: Certification Schemes For Curricula and Training Materials and Certification Scheme for the Certification of Persons [the SEL trainer], discussed how the certification scheme will take place and what it should contain. The meeting ended with the partners agreeing on some important deadlines.

During the second and final day of the meeting, the partners discussed and agreed on PR6: Digital Resource Center and Networking Tool For Synchronous Electronic Learning [SEL] Trainer, more specifically OMEGATECH, as the leading organisation of PR6, presented and discussed the steps that will be taken in the future regarding the tools and the platform. All partners gave their input in regards to the matter and agreed on a mutual deadline for the first draft of the tools and the platform. Moreover, ASNOR raised the topic of translations of the training materials, and all partners agreed on the proposed deadline. The meeting ended with all partners confirming that will meet again virtually, to present their final training materials.

Overall, the 3rd Transnational Meeting was very productive and beneficial for everyone who participated. It was a great pleasure for the partners to meet again and share fruitful ideas for the project's progression. These two successful days ended with the confirmation of the 4th TPM in Poland on the second half of 2024.
